

ABTA LifeLine was established to help people in the travel industry when they need it most.

By awarding financial grants to those suffering real financial hardship caused by life changing medical conditions, bereavement, disability, domestic violence and everything in between, we are here to help support the welfare of your staff and their families across the travel industry.

Sometimes it only takes a small change in circumstances to turn a manageable situation into an unmanageable one. From emergency repairs to wheelchairs, everyday essentials and household bills - nothing is too big or too small for us to consider.

Over the last 30 years we have helped over 800 families, awarding grants totalling in excess of £1 million.

### People we've helped



Jane

After 15 years working in the travel industry, Jane was forced to stopworking when her husband was suddenly diagnosed with prostate cancer. With unexpected medical costs and loss in income, the stresses of paying every day bills started to take its toll. Jane reached out to ABTA LifeLine for support. ABTA LifeLine were able to help the couple pay some priority bills, send grocery vouchers and purchase a special therapeutic mattress topper for Jane's husband.

Zach's mum Tricy, a former travel agent got in touch with ABTA LifeLine with a plea for help. ### How to apply



ABTA LifeLine is here to help travel industry colleagues in times of hardship. We do our absolute best to provide the most effective help to each individual's personal situation.

In order to determine how best we can help, we need to make a thorough assessment of circumstances, including the individual's current financial situation.

There are several ways for your employee to apply:

- ⇒ They can complete an enquiry form on our website abtalifeline.org.uk
- ⇒ Get in touch with us at lifeline@abtalifeline.org.uk
- ⇒ And, you can set up a referral service through your HR Department so they can refer colleagues in need directly to us

Applicants also need to demonstrate that they have explored opportunities for help from the State and other supportive agencies.

Once we have confirmed eligibility we will send an application form.

- Or get in touch with us if you would like to bring any other ideas forward!




